Os echo de menos y espero que nos veamos pronto.

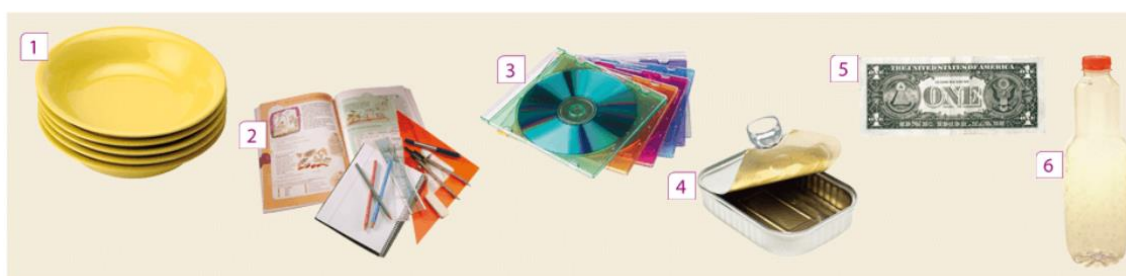
