## FIRST CONDITIONAL

CONDITIONAL CLAUSE

MAIN CLAUSE

If + verb in present simple

Future (**will** + verb)

If we win the prize,

we will buy a new car.

- \* The word "if" (si) introduce la conditional clause.
- \* We use the first conditional to talk about **situations that are likely** (probable) **to happen.**

Example: If it's sunny tomorrow, we'll (we + will) go to the beach.

\* We use a **comma** (,) to separate the two clauses.

Example: If I study hard, I'll pass the exams.

\* We can **change the order** of a conditional sentence. In this case, there is no comma.

Example: I'll pass the exams if I study hard.

\* There must be a subject in each clause.

Example: If I pass all my exams, my parents will give me a present.
